



Safety Policy



The Region of Waterloo International Airport shall:

- provide and promote a safe working environment for employees, contractors, visitors and airport users
- make every effort to prevent incidents by proactively identifying hazards and working to reduce or eliminate them
- continuously improve safety by identifying industry best practices and opportunities for the enhancement of our procedures
- provide the information, training and supervision necessary to enable our employees to collaboratively participate in the identification and effective mitigation of safety hazards and risks

Management must ensure that the equipment, processes, materials and devices necessary to ensure a safe airport environment are available and maintained in good condition and that employees work in compliance with both Airport and Regional safety policies, programs and procedures.

Employees are required to report hazards and work in compliance with the Canadian Aviation Regulations, the Canada Labour Code Part II and its associated regulations and Airport and Regional safety policies, programs and procedures.
